

## Illuminate Live! Moodle Plugin

### What is Illuminate?

Illuminate is a web-based audio conferencing tool that allows for real-time discussions. Features include:

- Breakout rooms for small group discussion
- Text messaging
- Surveys and basic assessments
- Application sharing and desktop sharing
- A whiteboard with markup tools for visuals
- Recorded sessions for convenient play back

To take part in Illuminate conferences, you will need a headset or speakers and a microphone. The first time that you connect to Illuminate, you will need to run through some set-up routines that will run automatically from the server.

### To Join an Illuminate Meeting

**These instructions only apply to meetings scheduled using the Illuminate Live! Moodle plugin.**

If your instructor has utilized the Illuminate Live! Moodle plugin, then you can join Illuminate voice conference meetings from within your Moodle course space. Illuminate meetings appear with a light-bulb icon, like below:



## To join a meeting:

1. Click on the meeting link to view the meeting time.
2. A page appears listing the meeting title, description and time.
3. The **Join meeting** link will appear **15 minutes prior to the meeting start time only**. Click this link to join the meeting.

4. A window will appear asking whether you would like to open or save a file called “**meeting.jnlp**”. Choose **Open**.
5. The Elluminate applet will download and Elluminate will launch.
6. The connection speed window will appear. Your connection speed is automatically detected. Click **OK**.
7. You will be added to the Elluminate meeting automatically.
