


Navigating a Course

Moodle uses a “flat” navigation scheme to access the resources or activities on a course page. A course is made up of a mix of resources and activities. Resources are objects a student’s observe, like a webpage. Activities are objects students interact with, like discussion forums.


Breadcrumbs

Breadcrumbs are the primary method of navigation in Moodle. The breadcrumbs appear at the top of the course page. New pages get added to the end of the breadcrumb trail as you navigate a course and you can browse back to previous pages by clicking a link somewhere in the breadcrumb chain.

- If you click the first breadcrumb *GPRC Moodle*, then you are taken back to the MyMoodle page listing your courses.
- If you click the second breadcrumb, then you are taken back to the main course page.

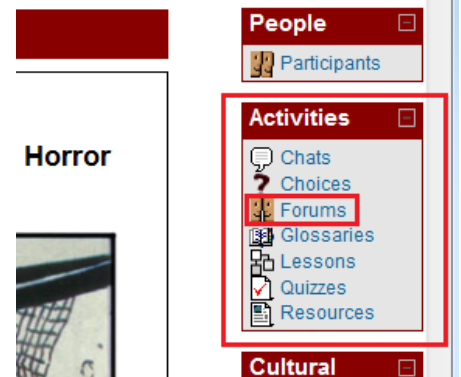

You can also access index pages by using the breadcrumb navigation bar from within an activity. The index page is one-level back from whatever activity you are viewing.

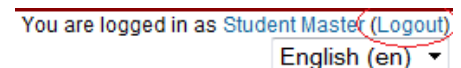
