**POLICY STATEMENT:**

It is the intention of the Grande Prairie Regional College to promote a clean air environment free of the ill effects of all second hand smoke.

The success of the policy largely depends on the mutual cooperation of all peoples within the College community.

**PURPOSE:** To ensure a healthy tobacco-free environment at Grande Prairie Regional College.

**SCOPE:** This policy applies to all individuals entering onto or near College controlled or owned buildings. The policy also applies to all drivers and passengers of College vehicles.

**DEFINITIONS:**

**PROCEDURE/GUIDELINES:**

Smoking is prohibited in all College-owned buildings and vehicles. All entrances to the main College building are designated and clearly marked as "Smoke-Free Entries" and smoking at these entrances is strictly prohibited.

Smoking is permitted at the following designated and clearly marked areas (See Appendix 1):

1. Southeast corner of Parking Lot A
2. Main Entry near bus stop
3. NAIT Building near southwest parking lot
4. M-Wing near east end of planter
5. Southwest corner of Health Clinic
6. Between Studio A and B near shed

Students, staff and contractors will be advised of the Clean Air Policy prior to their arrival at the College.

### **Non Compliance with the Clean Air Policy**

It is the responsibility of all members of the College community to adhere to the Clean Air Policy and to bring the provisions of the policy to the attention of potential violators.

### **Exceptions**

Exceptions to the Clean Air policy can be made through the Vice-President, Administration for ceremonial purposes, i.e., smudging, peace pipe ceremony.
