Important Dates

Drop Date: Dual credit students have 2 weeks from the start of class to drop a course, please note this is longer than other GPRC students. If you start your course and realize it is not going to fit into your schedule or you're not prepared to take this course, talk to your school's Guidance Counsellor or GPRC's Dual Credit Coordinator to drop your course. When a course is dropped, it will not show on your official GPRC transcript that you even registered.

Withdrawal Date: If you're past the two week drop period and are concerned with your progress in the course, first speak to your instructor to see if you can get help. If it is determined that withdrawing from your course would be in your best interest, GPRC has a withdraw date specific to each semester. When a student withdraws from a course, the course will remain on their GPRC transcript, but the student will receive a grade of W, not affecting their GPA. Please discuss with your school's Guidance Counsellor how this will affect your high school transcript.

Contact GPRC's Dual Credit Coordinator to confirm drop and withdraw dates and to have the paper work completed.

Parking

Parking is provided for dual credit students. If you are taking a course in the evening (after 4:30pm) you can park in any lot without a pass. If your course is during the day, your Dual Credit Coordinator will provide you with a parking pass. If you receive a parking ticket and believe you shouldn't have, take it to the Dual Credit Coordinator right away and they will help you work with Security.
