Students must present a valid driver's license or learner's permit. It is also recommended that students bring a full body harness and a four foot non-shock absorbing lanyard.

#### **CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:**

This aerial lift training program consists of class theory and a practical evaluation. Participants will understand the design and limitations of an aerial lift device, know how to conduct a pre-use inspection, demonstrate safe operating procedures, know the roles and responsibilities for safe operation, and understand the principles and interpretation of the "Envelope Management System".

Students will have the ability to operate a lift, in a safe manner, once they have completed this course. This course includes Scissor Lift and Articulated Lift.
