CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:

This one-day course is intended for all workers in the petroleum industry who could be exposed to Hydrogen Sulphide (H₂S). Each student is required to operate self-contained breathing apparatus, a detector tube device, and participate in CPR and rescue lift and drag exercises. This course is certified by ENFORM.
