PREREQUISITE(S)/COREQUISITE: Minimum age requirement of 18 years. Students must present a valid Alberta driver's license or learner's permit.

REQUIRED TEXT/RESOURCE MATERIALS: Textbook is supplied

CALENDAR DESCRIPTION: In this 2 day course, students will learn to recognize and provide interventions for life-threatening emergencies until medical aid arrives. This course includes Level C CPR Training and certification (Adult, Child, Infant, and 2-rescuer resuscitation) and AED training and certification.
