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PREREQUISITE(S)/COREQUISITE:

Students must present a valid driver's license or learner's permit. Students must be at least 18 years of age to attend this course. Students are required to bring steel-toed boots to class.

REQUIRED TEXT/RESOURCE MATERIALS: Textbook is supplied

CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:

This one-day course includes 4 hours of lecture and videos, 4 hours of demonstration and hands-on training followed by a proficiency demonstration, and an Operator Performance Evaluation. Students will experience both classroom and practical training for a Wheeled Loader. They will understand safe handling of loads, pre-use inspections, safe task procedures, and Workplace Health and Safety Regulations in respect to the operation of mobile equipment.

CREDIT/CONTACT HOURS: 8 hours

DELIVERY MODE(S): Face to face

OBJECTIVES (OPTIONAL):

After completing this training, participants will:

- Understand fundamentals of safe wheeled loader operation
- Have the ability to conduct pre-use inspections
- Safely operate the wheeled loader and associated attachments
- Safely handle loads

- Understand safe task procedures
- Understand Workplace Health and Safety Regulations in respect to the operation of mobile equipment
