The student with the guidance of an instructor will develop a body of work over the year. The work must be accompanied by an artist's statement addressing the content around the work. Evaluation:

- 1. Level of engagement: the student must be highly engaged with both the process and the content of the work.
- **2.** Completion of assigned tasks as per course criteria: Images, statement, exhibition,
- 3. Quality of work: This includes the level of creativity and craftsmanship demonstrated and the degree of knowledge and understanding of the elements and principles of this particular studio discipline.
- 4. Ongoing presentation of the work will be required throughout the duration of this course.
