FOUNDATIONS OF REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL**

**TEXT:** Course material supplied by the Real Estate Division of the University of British Columbia

**PREREQUISITE:** Financial Mathematics BA 1050 or consent of the instructor

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course is an introduction to the concepts and techniques of appraising the value of real estate. It begins with an introduction to the appraisal profession and organization in Canada and summarizes the appraisal process. The three classic approaches to value are presented and analyzed as they may be applied to single family and small, multi-family residential properties.

**COURSE OBJECTIVE:** This course gives a basic introduction to real estate appraisal.

**TRANSFERABILITY:** The course transfers to the Appraisal Institute of Canada's CRA program and the UBC's BUSI 330 course.
