1. Course Description: Private instruction in piano.
 2. Prerequisite: Consent of the Department and/or audition.
 3. The Course in Perspective: The purpose of this course is to expand the technical and musical capabilities and experiences of each student. Improved proficiency will be achieved through the performance of various musical styles, sight reading, ear training and technical exercises.
 4. Recitals: Students will attend all student recitals and perform in at least one recital per term.
 5. Grading: The student's grade will be determined by the following weighting:
 - A) 40% for performance in a jury at the end of each term.
 - B) 20% for recital participation.
 - C) 30% for lesson preparation and demonstrated development.
 - D) 10% for attendance at 12 of 16 MAD presentations.
 - E) Absence from three lessons will constitute a fail for the course.
