**Course Description -** This is an opportunity for students to showcase their collective abilities through the production of a 1 hour multimedia public performance. All students will be involved as either performers, technicians, coordinators, or all of the above. This is a great chance for students to share ownership of a collective creative endeavour. Students will hone their improvisational skills through the realization of original compositions in an ensemble situation. They will involve students from both the Visual Arts and Drama Depts. as they see fit to complete the vision of their production.

**Grading -** The students grade will be derived as follows:  
- 85% - participation  
- 15% - attendance in class and for additional rehearsals

**Progression Policy -** All students in a Fine Arts Dept. course who are absent from more than 20% of one of their classes may be told to leave that class. Further, if students fail to complete and submit 85% of the graded requirements of the term mark, they will not be allowed to write the final exam, or complete the course. In such a case the student will automatically receive a failing grade of 0 (debarred). Students should receive timely notice if they fall below the 85% submission

requirement. They have the right to appeal to the registrar should they be told to leave the class. It is a Fine Arts Dept. guideline that students will lose 10% a calendar day for submitting projects due after the due date. After ten days, a grade of zero will be recorded.
