Course Description: A continuation of DD1081 with more of an emphasis on composition, as well as recording and production techniques for live and studio applications.

Prerequisite: DD1081

Course in perspective: This course will develop skills learned in DD1081 with a stronger emphasis on composition. Topics will include basic acoustic principles, microphones, recording techniques using a multitrack digital recorder, mixing board and outboard processing equipment, as well as a more in depth look at MIDI sequencing and theoretical principles pertaining to acoustics.
