Description:

Objectives:

1. Introduction to and understanding of the creative process of drama.
2. Understanding of creativity and the application of the creative process of drama to the development of human resources especially in children and young people.
3. Understanding of the early levels of the creative process as preparation for experience in theatre art.

Syllabus:

1. Theory of the creative process of drama and development of personal resources through drama.
2. Research into the nature of creativity and the creative individual.
3. Examination of and experience in progressive levels of the creative process of drama.
4. Application of the creative process of drama to work with children and teenagers.

Techniques:

1. Lectures and discussion.
2. Individual, small group and whole group exercises, activities and projects.
