CALENDAR DESCRIPTION: The jazz ensemble is a performing group consisting of brass, woodwind, string, and percussion instruments that plays jazz band literature in at least two concerts per year. Students will gain experience prerforming ensemble literature from a variety of periods and genres. Participation in either the jazz or wind ensemble is a requirement or corequisite for students taking applied music and is open to other college students and members of the community.

OBJECTIVES (OPTIONAL): The development of playing skills to match the difficulty of the music.
