The student's hometown must be located in Alberta 100 km from Grande Prairie and the student has to relocate to attend GPRC or is commuting to Grande Prairie on a regular basis to attend college. Must be a Grade 12 graduate with entrance requirements to a post-secondary institution. Selection based on top five Grade 12 core subjects, attaining at least a 60%. Applicant must complete the Elizabeth Jean Butler Scholarship application. If attending GPRC you must complete the GPRC Entrance Application as well.
