Approval of Tuition Fee Schedule, 2011-2012

In accordance with the Post-Secondary Learning Act, 61(1) the Board of Governors shall set the tuition fees to be paid by students.

As directed by the Tuition Fee Policy, the Dean of Student Experience has drafted a Tuition Fee Schedule for 2011-2012 and has received feedback for consensus from GPRC Executive, Senior Administration, Deans and Chairs Council, Administrative Council, Students' Association Executive and Student Council.

In reviewing the tuition fee proposals and the related criteria and associated data, the opinions of the various stakeholders through an extensive consultation process have been considered and the attached Tuition Fee for 2011-2012 is recommended for approval. The fee schedule will be published in the College Calendar and the GPRC Business Plan

The Tuition Fee Policy limits tuition to not exceed 30% of the net operating costs.

MOVED by J. Clayton, **seconded** by P. Merlo, the Board of Governors approves the recommended tuition fee schedule of 2011-2012, consistent with the provincial mandate, indicating an increase of .35%.
